MARY F. HARRIS BROWN was born in Baltimore, Maryland to the late Frank and Martha Harris on March 1, 1926. She departed this life suddenly on Thursday, October 13, 2011 after dealing with the grief of losing her husband.

Mary attended Dunbar High in Baltimore City. She continued her education and in 1975 earned her BA Degree in Mental Health and Human Services from Antioch College in Baltimore, Maryland.

Mary accepted Christ in her life at an early age and was baptized by the late Rev. Simon Williamson and remained a member of Faith Baptist Church. During these years she faithfully served in the gospel group called the Harris Sisters with her mother and three sisters Lillian, Thelma and Elsie.
