Betty Jean Williamson, born Jean Connor in Baltimore, Maryland on December 1, 1940, was the daughter of the late Elisha Connor and the late Brittanous Connor Brown and her husband, Sylvester F. Brown. Surrounded by her family, Betty received the promise of eternal life just before sunset on Thursday, July 29, 2021.

Betty was educated in the Baltimore City Public Schools, where she attended Eastern High School. On July 26, 1957, at the age of 16, Betty married the love of her life, the late Harold Emmanuel Williamson, Sr. Five children were born from this union: Kathy, Cynthia, Harold Jr., Wayne and Christopher.

After giving her life to Christ in the 1980's, Betty attended Manna Bible Baptist Church and went on to become a charter member of Genesis Bible Fellowship Church. There she served in various capacities such as the Leadership Wives ministry and the flower ministry, where she used her talents to design altar flowers.

Betty deeply loved her family; her family deeply loved her. She enjoyed spending holidays, sharing meals and celebrations, and time at the beach with them as often as she could. She was a wonderful, devoted and Godly mother, grandmother, great grandmother and great-great grandmother. We are all beneficiaries of her fervent prayers on our behalf.


I know that God is faithful to supply all that each person needs! And I believe that He will do just that!
