Calvin Mc Kee Rhames, son of the late Bessie Howard Rhames Bromley and Harvey Rhames Jr. was born on June 3, 1955, in Baltimore, Maryland. He was the fifth child born in a family of seven children. He ascended this life on Tuesday, May 24, 2022, after a lengthy illness at Orchard Hill Rehab and Long-Term Care facility.

Calvin resided in East Baltimore except when he lived briefly in California and Pennsylvania. He loved his East Baltimore community and the many long-lasting friendships he made throughout the years. He loved his apartment on Charles Street and living in the downtown Baltimore area where he had easy access to the various festivals and activities like Artscape.

Calvin received his education in the Baltimore City School system, graduating from Lake Clifton High School in 1974. After graduation, he began his working career at Union Memorial Hospital in the Linen Department. Calvin worked various jobs before his retirement on April 1, 2022 from Greater Baltimore Medical Center after 12 years of service. He was planning to retire at the end of 2022 and move to Florida for the warmer weather. He was always cold and did not like the Baltimore winter weather.

Calvin and Sylvia Waters were joined in holy matrimony in 1984. From this union there was one son, Fernando Rhames.

Late in life, Calvin gave his life to Christ at Zion Baptist Church.

He made a point of calling his siblings every week just to say, "hello" and to find out how they were doing. We will all miss those calls.
