



## Christina Singleton Milton

July 6, 1938 - March 3, 2022

On July 6, 1938, CHRISTINA SINGLETON MILTON was born on James Island, an island community in Charleston, South Carolina, to the late Louis Singleton and Alma Green Singleton. She found her rest with Father God on Thursday, March 3, 2022.

Christina was the third child and the oldest daughter of eight children. After graduating from Burke High School in Charleston, she briefly moved to New York City to pursue nursing school. Upon her return to Charleston, she met and married Marion Milton, Sr., and from this union two children were born, the late Marion Milton, Jr. and Alma Milton Green (Danny Green - deceased).

In 1965, Christina relocated to Baltimore where she lived for twenty-three years while working at Silver Cross Home, Ft. Meade and raising her children. In 1988 she returned to Charleston to care for her mother. She retired from Roper Hospital in Charleston and returned to Baltimore in 2005.

Christina loved family and at an early age positioned herself as the family matriarch offering love, support and guidance to those in her family who called on her to help navigate life. Christina was a woman of deep faith, kind, caring, giving and resilient. She possessed a strength of character and wisdom that could be seen in her that no matter the circumstance of life, whether good or bad, she willed herself to push through hard situations and while doing so encouraged others by her determination to live life with purpose.

Preceding her in death were her brothers, Albert Singleton, Edward Singleton and her sister, Laura M. Goss. She leaves to celebrate her life: her daughter, Alma J. Green and granddaughter Daneshia Davis; siblings, Louis Singleton of Charleston, SC; William Singleton of Baltimore, MD; John F. Singleton of Baltimore, MD and Doris S.
