Before retiring after over twenty-five years in public service, Daisy worked as a Computer Key Punch Operator and a Claims Examiner for the Social Security Administration.

Daisy also enjoyed working as a volunteer with Enoch Pratt Public Library and later with the Share Food Program for Seniors, where she delivered fresh meals to the elderly.
