Elswiter M. Easy was born on May 22, 1927 to Hannah B. and Thomas T. Mayne in Tweedside, Jamaica, W.I. She transitioned this earthy life for a heavenly home on March 4, 2019 after a lengthy illness.

Elswiter migrated from Jamaica to the United States in the early 1960s and enthusiastically saw that family members followed her. She loved her family dearly and loved to teach others, particularly children. She attended Morgan State College and Coppin State Teachers College where she received her Bachelor's Degree in Early Childhood Education; later receiving her Master's Degree from Loyola University. She worked as an elementary and middle school teacher in the Baltimore City School System until her retirement in the mid-1980s.

Affectionately called "Girly" by family and friends she was a devoted mother, sister, aunt, grand aunt and most importantly devoted Christian and Child of God. She was a founding member of the Prince of Peace Baptist Church under the late Pastor Moses Williams, Pastor Terrance Leathers and most recently Pastor Barry K. Hargrove. She remained a member in good standing and was ordained as a Deacon in February 2000 under Pastor Leathers' leadership. She carried on her gift for teaching and served as a Sunday school teacher and served on the church's Missionary Society. One of Elswiter highlights was ensuring that her family heard the word of God and would invite everyone she could to Friends and Family Day; frequently having one of the largest number of guests. Laughing and spending time with her family always gave her great joy.

Preceding her in death is her mother, father and siblings; Tom, Frankie, Bob, Ula, Ester, and Vera. Elswiter leaves to mourn her passing her beloved son Paul T. Smith, a devoted nephew
