### Evora Haskins Obituary

Evora Madglean Haskins was born to John and Catherine Bazemore on February 23, 1930 in Bertie County, North Carolina. She transitioned to glory early in the morning on January 24, 2019. During her younger years she was educated in Bertie County public schools.

In 1948 she married Forrest Cherry. From this union three children were born, Ralph, Carolyn, and Olivia. By the late 1950's Evora, Forrest, and their children migrated from North Carolina, to Baltimore, Maryland with a stop in Portsmouth, Virginia. Early in her working life, Evora was a domestic worker later working as a school custodian and school bus driver. The last formal job she would take was as a Meals-on-Wheels Coordinator for Bon Secure Hospital in Baltimore, Maryland.

Following the end of her first marriage, she married Rev. James O. Haskins in 1966. This union gave her an additional son, Marvin. Evora was raised in strong Christian family and she carried those values with her to Baltimore. In Baltimore, she and her family worshipped at New Pilgrim Baptist Church under Pastor Willie Black. With her marriage to Rev. Haskins, she went with him as he took pastoral roles at Little Macedonia Baptist Church and Hallelujah Baptist Church. She was a first lady, choir member and usher and Sunday school teacher at all of these churches. Following their time at Hallelujah Baptist Church, she and Rev. Haskins worshipped at Old Landmark Baptist Church. Following Rev. Haskins death, she worshipped at North Star Baptist Church with until her health failed her.

Her biggest joy was being with family. She maintained a deep love for all of her siblings and she her sisters in Baltimore were affectionately dubbed "the golden girls". She happily became a homemaker to care for her children, nieces, nephews, grandchildren and great grandchildren going so far as legally adopting her great-granddaughter Whitney Cherry. Preceding her in death are her two husbands Forrest Cherry and James Haskins as well as two of her children, Ralph Cherry and Olivia Cherry.

She leaves to cherish her memory, one daughter Carolyn Scott; one son, Marvin Haskins. One brother John Bazemore (Bonnie), three sisters, Elneray Martin; Erma Ford; Pauline Williams (Phil) and a host of grandchildren, great-grandchildren, nieces, nephews,

cousins, and friends.
