Gail Powell was born October 15, 1956 in Cleveland, Ohio to the late Moses and Luella Mitchell, both preceded her in death. She was the youngest of 12 children. Gail spent her early childhood in Cleveland, Ohio and was educated in the Seventh Day Adventist Church educational system. Gail relocated to Newport News, Virginia in the mid 1960s with her parents, and in 1975 graduated from Warwick High School. Gail became a clerk typist at Fort Monroe Army Base, and was a Deaconess at Clavery Seventh Day Adventist Church. She later became a crossing guard for the Newport News Public School system.

In 1984, Gail met and fell in love with Melvin Powell, Sr. at a church picnic. At the encouragement of her late mother-in-law Antoinette Powell, Gail and Melvin Sr. enrolled at Hampton University and completed one year of higher education. They were married on March 8, 1985.

She worked for Sinai Hospital, a LifeBridge Health Center, and medically retired in June 2019 after 28 years of service. Gail was called home by the Lord on September 5, 2019 after a long fought battle with cancer.

Gail also enjoyed spending her time shopping at her favorite stores, ROSS included. She had a true talent for finding the most beautiful, useful, and unique gifts.
