Marvin was the youngest of seven children, baby of the family, and greatly loved by all his siblings.

He attended Baltimore City Public Schools and was a graduate of Forest Park Senior High School.

In his younger days Marvin attended Star of Bethlehem A.M.E. Church.

Marvin was first employed by the Baltimore Gas and Electric Company and he later worked for Bethlehem Steel for thirty years until retirement. He was a union man and a shop steward at Bethlehem Steel who strived to achieve better work conditions and improvements for his fellow employees.

In later years, he struggled with health issues and was a kidney transplant recipient donated by his sister, Sandra.

Marvin was a kind and generous person. He read a lot and liked to debate. We, his siblings, jokingly used to say, "There's Marvin on his soapbox". He also loved listening to jazz.

Marvin was preceded in death by his brother, Kenneth Hill.

Marvin leaves to cherish his memory: his loving wife, Eloise; two stepsons, Shawn and Antoine; one daughter, Sharron; one grandson, Kenny (from a previous marriage); five step-grandchildren, Brandon, Andrew, Damon-tay, Ciera and Shawn; one brother, Ellsworth Hill; four sisters, Collen Countess, Verna Jubilee, Jaqueline Winkey and Sandra Vincent; and a host of nieces and nephews.
