



Payton Tyrone Butler, Jr.

July 2, 1965 - October 25, 2021

Payton Tyrone Butler Jr., 56 was born in Richmond, Virginia on July 2, 1965. He was the youngest of three children to Payton Sr. and Louise. He grew up in Hechler Village and attended schools in Henrico County Public Schools. He was baptized at the Fourth Baptist Church of Richmond as a teenager. Payton graduated from Highland Springs School (STEM) and Virginia State University with a B.S. in Computer Science, where he played drums in the mighty marching band and pledged Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity Inc. (and was pinned by his father who was also a Sigma).

Payton Jr. was an elite computer programmer and analyst who loved doing coding and sports analytics. He was a loyal and devoted employee with Hewlett-Packard Development Company, I.P. 1-JP/DXC Technology & Gainwell. His coworkers lauded him as a team player who was patient, soft-spoken and did the most complex coding for their projects. He served with honor on the first mandated health care known as Romneycare for the State of Massachusetts. Payton intentionally and creatively specialized in bringing joy and excitement to others as an event host, Disc Jockey, Rappe, and Technology Analyst. He has experienced joy hosting great parties at his home and formerly at Virginia State University, cookouts, Payton Sr. Butler Affair annual 4th of July cookouts, and beach birthday celebrations at Virginia Beach and Myrtle Beach. Payton's hobbies included performing (Virginia State Marching Band; DJ, and former rappers); playing basketball at the gym, football analysis (created fantasy football app), tennis leagues, collecting Alfs and throwback jerseys/hats, and swimming.

Payton departed this life on October 25, 2021, and leaves to mourn his devoted and loving wife Gwendolyn and son Tyler Butler; mother Louise Butler and mother-in-law Louise Allen; sisters Kimberley B. Green, and Dr. Phoebe B. Ajibade (Muritala); brother-in-laws Laverl Morris (Aarionett), Roosevelt Allen and Nadir Lumumba (deceased) uncles James and Harvey Butler, Gregory Cosby, Robert Cosby, and Norman Underwood; aunts Etta and Patricia Butler, Joyce Byrd and Denise Cosby, niece Jenae Green, and a host of nieces, nephews and cousins; his brothers from Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity, Inc.
