



## Quinton D. Miles Sr.

October 23, 1984 - October 7, 2021

Quinton Demond Miles, Sr. was born on October 23, 1984, in Richmond, Virginia to Thomas Miles, Sr., and Queen Miles. He went home to be with the Lord on Thursday, October 7, 2021, at the Virginia Commonwealth University Medical Center, surrounded by his devoted wife Melissa, other family members, and VCU staff.

Quinton was the second of the three Miles children born to his parents and enjoyed his status as the middle child. He graduated from Huguenot High School in Richmond where he played the saxophone in the popular Huguenot Marching Band. He continued his studies at J. Sargeant Reynolds Community College for two years. After completing studies at Reynolds, Quinton furthered his education at Old Dominion University of Norfolk, Virginia earning a Bachelor's degree in Business Management with a minor in Computer Science.

He was a dedicated employee for K-Line America for years and later transferred to Owens and Minor, where he held a position as a Transportation Planner.

At an early age, he came to know Christ and was baptized at the St. John's United Holy Church. Having grown up in the church, Quinton was deeply committed to his faith and became a very active disciple, serving as an usher, a member of the new member orientation committee, church drummer, a member of VISION Young Adult Choir, a Sunday School Teacher, a member of the Security Team and Tech Team, and most recently serviced on the Deacons' Ministry. Quinton even performed in many plays produced by the Wright Penn Company. He excelled in everything that he committed to without complaint.

Though reserved and serious-minded, Quinton had an awesome sense of humor and loved to laugh. In many ways, he was a role model for his generation. Persons who knew him would find he had a great listening ear and could easily confide in him. He was always ready to accommodate anyone in any situation. Quinton was known to apply his analytical skills in most situations, so others knew not to expect any quick or careless responses

from him. If anything didn't make sense to him he would definitely verbalize it. Quinton loved spending time with family every chance he could, whether it was near or far. He was a dedicated father and loved his children, never missing a moment with them. Quinton and his children would have a saying when they parted ways, "Bye, love you, love you too, bye, good night". Quinton was a fighter, never giving up easily on anything he faced.

Quinton married the love of his life, Melissa Shearin in September of 2009 and they shared twelve beautiful years with each other. Together, they strived to be a model of marriage and loving cooperation to many young adults. Melissa was at Quinton's side and attentively cared and advocated for him during his time in the hospital.

He leaves to cherish his memory: wife, Melissa; daughters, Jayla, Ayva and Alivia; son, Quinton Jr. "QJ"; parents, Deacon Thomas and Mother Queen Miles; three siblings, Katrina, Thomas Jr. (Jamie), and Candace; father and mother-in-law, Elder Marion Shearin and Sis. Brenda Shearin; brother-in-law, Jason (Terror); godmother, Bernice Shepperson; godchild, Brenden Jones; a nephew he treated like a son, Corwin Porter; and an array of aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews, cousins, lifetime friends, and others who loved him as a son. Quinton will be greatly missed, but his legacy of leadership and friendship will forever be treasured by all of his colleagues, family members, and the St. John's United Holy Church family.


