Aaron Jerome Wiggins was born on Tuesday, March 15, 1961 to his loving parents, Veronica Dorothy Holley-Wiggins and Edward Jerome Wiggins, in Providence, Rhode Island.

Aaron attended Lafayette Elementary school in Baltimore, Maryland, before he transferred to St. Edwards (also in Baltimore, Maryland). As a child, Aaron was an opened minded, kind boy who could always make you laugh; he never lost any of those traits throughout his life.

Aaron worked a few various jobs after graduating from St. Francis High School; shortly after, he decided to join the Air Force to better himself. He was honorably discharged from the force after serving his country for a period of time, then worked another set of various jobs until he began working alongside his mother, a spirited entrepreneur who ran a number of active businesses.
