Adikie had a profound and everlasting effect on many people in both her professional and personal life. She is the mother of two, Jared and Jordan who she greatly loved and always esteemed as her main purpose for living. She was a generous and dedicated individual who constantly gave of herself

and her gifts to others. Anointed with empathy and compassion, she was intentional about changing the world. " Moving beyond the spectrum and into bright futures" Adikie believed that every child especially those with autism, could flourish in this world and rise above stereotypes; Her belief fueled her pursuit of teaching children with special needs and later opening her own business. She often worked tirelessly to ensure her students and their families received services to help them live their best life. In 2014, Adikie co-founded Advancing Beyond the Spectrum LLC; taking on the role of Clinical Director, Adikie was a beacon and light, who will forever shine in our lives. She will be greatly missed yet certainly never forgotten.
