On August 9th, 2019, Adrienne Jackson, loving mother of three children, passed away at the age of 55. Adrienne was born on June 29th, 1964 in Baltimore, Maryland to William and Juanita Blueford.

She received her high school diploma at Western High School and then went on to attend Towson University. Adrienne dedicated 18 years to the United States Postal Service until she retired to become a full-time stay at home mom in 1997.
