AP was a dedicated employee and a mentor to many of the officers. He earned the respect of many of his colleagues as well as the inmates. After his retirement, AP joined Maryland General Hospital Security team. AP was a family man. He was the youngest boy of 8 children, a loving brother and a protector of his sisters. AP was avid sports fan of the Ravens and Orioles. AP loved reading mystery novels, and he enjoyed playing cards at Windsor Inn with friends. When he was home his favorite pastime was watching a good Western, Family Feud, and The Young and the Restless. AP's life changed when he met and married Pamela D. Quarles in 1995. He called Pamela his best friend and companion. It wasn't a day that went by that they did not communicate.
