Mr. Albert Smith was born in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania on May 2, 1934. He was the son of the late Edward P. (Pretty) and Maggie Davis. Al moved to Baltimore in 1950, where he began his singing career at the age of sixteen. He helped form the doo-wop group "The Mending Hearts." He also sang bass for many other groups, most notably, "The Swallows," with whom numerous hits were produced. In addition to his singing career, he also had a career with the City of Baltimore, which began in 1969 and ended with his retirement in 1998. Albert lived a long, happy life until God called him home to rest on August 19, 2004. He had been ill for just a short time. Albert leaves to mourn his passing: one sister, Marie Davis; three brothers, Adolph Smith, Willie Edward Davis and Edward Davis Jr. of Camden, S.C.; two sons, Albert Jr. and Anthony; four daughters, Deborah, Adele, Alveta and Renee; two ex-wives, Vivian and Rose; companion, Phyllis; fifteen grandchildren, four great-grandchildren and a host of cousins, nieces, nephews, friends and neighbors.
