She attended the Baltimore City Public School System graduating from Frederick Douglass Senior High School in June of 1928 and Coppin normal School where she completed two years and received her Teacher's Certificate in 1930, making her eligible to teach at Elementary Schools.

Louise worked as substitute teacher and taught night school for several years before she went to work for Glenn L. Martin as a riveter. She landed a job working for the State of Maryland for the Comptroller of the Treasury in the Income Tax Division
