Albertine Caroline Brewster was born on the island of Tobago on February 13, 1940 to the late Noah Ceasar and Irene Hector. She was one of Noah Ceasar's thirty children. Albertine was known as "Tina" to her friends and more affectionately as "Puncy" to her family.

She migrated to Trinidad at the age of fifteen to live her older brother, Philip. She had three children while in Trinidad and was employed in a variety of industries. In 1970 she migrated to the United States. She was employed by the Davis and Knight families and later became a Nursing Assistant at Keswick Nursing Center. In 1989 she changed employers to Sinai Hospital and became a Patient Care Associate. She retired from Sinai in 2002.

Tina was well known for her jovial nature. She could always make a joke or have an old time saying that would express her opinion such as: "If Miss Mary's cat have kittens, we must have a party," "the candle cost more than the funeral" or "every pot must sit on their own bottom." She was proud of the fact that she was born Tobogonian. Never say that she was from Trinidad without saying Tobago.

Tina was a staunch member of the Trinidad and Tobago Association of Baltimore. Her soon, Anthony, was a founding member of the association and from the very first meeting Tina ha been an up to date dues paying member.
