ALEASE HALL, daughter of the late Harry and Pearl Tucker, was born on February 25, 1926 in Mecklenburg County, Virginia. Alease was the eldest of three children born to the union of her parents. Siblings Russell and Leonard Tucker preceded her in death. She peacefully transitioned to her heavenly home early Sunday morning February 19, 2023.

Alease was a graduate of Thyme Institute in Chase City, Virginia. On April 23, 1946 she married the late William Riley Hall and out of this union two sons were born; Ernest (who preceded her in death) and Ronnie. In 1954 Alease relocated with her husband and children to Baltimore, Maryland. For a short period of time Mrs. Hall was employed with Bugle Laundry. She was a dedicated homemaker for many years.

She accepted Christ at an early age and was baptized at Concord Baptist Church in Chase City, Virginia. In April 1989 Sister Hall united with Mt. Sinai Baptist Church, during a Holy Week Service when she was moved by Pastor Prentice's sermon "Warming Up By The Wrong Fire" She joined under the leadership of the late Reverend William Brown. Later under the leadership of Pastor Ray A. Cotton Sister Hall worked diligently with various ministries of the church. She enjoyed her service with the Sunday School breakfast committee. She also served as an around-the-clock Prayer Warrior. Mother Hall was a long term active member of the Missions Ministry until her passing.

An avid Bible student, Sister Hall was a Sunday School and Bible Study participant. She was one of the first attendees of Mt. Sinai's Noonday Bible Study Fellowship. At age 96 Sister Hall was the eldest senior member of the Mt. Sinai Baptist Church. She was not only a good student but also a good cook. Pastor Cotton can attest that she made the best cabbage ever. As her health began to decline Mother Hall moved in with her son Ronnie and his wife Sandra.

A quiet and gentle soul with a jolly laugh, Mother Alease will be remembered as a great asset to the Mt. Sinai Baptist Church for her spirit, her service and her support. Her favorite scripture was 1 Corinthians 13.

She leaves to cherish her memory a very devoted son Ronnie, a devoted daughter-in-law Sandra, three grandsons Eric, Jerrod and Rodney Hall (Laniece); eight great-grandchildren, two great-great-grandchildren and a host of other relatives and friends.
