Alex, Jr. was a popular member of the Aberdeen Bible Church family, although he was one of the youngest. A regular comment among church members was "He's such a good baby." Both Ronda's and Alex's coworkers regularly asked them to bring Alex, Jr. in for visits. He was such a pleasant baby who was rarely cranky, which was why he was always invited back to visit wherever he went. Although his time on earth was short, Alex, Jr. had a very full life. He was a very active baby who was beginning the first stages of walking and talking, and he loved to talk, a trait which he obviously got from his mother. Baby Alex loved to crawl rapidly about his home, getting into the things babies regularly get into (like cabinets, trash cans, laundry baskets and

magazine racks). Baby Alex especially loved to wrestle around with his daddy or listen to a story read by his mommy.
