Alexander Casey, affectionately known as "Rubin" by family and close friends, transitioned peacefully on July 6, 2025, at the age of 100. Beloved son of the late Ben Casey and Susan Fraizer was born in South Carolina. He later made his home in Baltimore, Maryland, where he built a life rooted in service, strength, and family.

Rubin was the beloved husband of Barbara Casey and the devoted father of Cynthia, Gwen, Karen, Gregory (Paula), and Barney. He was preceded in death by his brother Willie, his children Betty Ann, George, Terrance, and Kevin. A cherished grandfather, he leaves behind more than 13 grandchildren who brought him joy, pride, and purpose.

Rubin was a United States Navy veteran, he served his country with honor for 21 years. Following his military service, he continued his commitment to protection and discipline as a dedicated security professional until his retirement. His life was marked by loyalty, resilience, and a deep sense of responsibility to those around him. Rubin gave his life to Christ in 1994 when he was baptized in the Jordan River at the HOLY LAND. Though he has departed this world, the impact of Rubin's life and love will remain forever in the hearts of those who knew him.
