ALFORD CARLINGTON DALY, son of the late Percy Anderson Nathaniel Daly and the late Shelah Eliena Daly, was born April 17, 1946, in San Fernando, Trinidad, West Indies. He departed this life on April 1, 2024.

At an early age, he became a member of Churkoo Seventh-Day Adventist Church in Princes Town. He graduated from St. John's College and then attended nursing school at St. Ann's Hospital, where he specialized in psychiatric nursing.

Alford emigrated to Baltimore, Maryland in 1972 and graduated from Helene Fuld School of Nursing in 1975. He worked at Montebello Rehabilitation Hospital, Maryland General Hospital, Bayview Burn Center and several other hospitals and nursing homes. He also worked in adult day care centers and as a correctional nurse.

Alford met Debbie Moore in 1989 while they were both working at Seton Hall Manor Nursing Center. With his encouragement, she also attended nursing school and became a registered nurse. They were married in 1997 and remained devoted to each other until he passed. Together they enjoyed traveling and attending shows. He loved Caribbean festivals and listening to music, especially calypso and soca. One of his biggest passions was caring for dozens of birds and fish. He also loved cars, driving and cooking.
