January 13, 1913 - January 5, 2015

On January 5, 2015, ALICE H. LISBY, beloved member of Payne Memorial African Methodist Episcopal Church, was covered by grace and passed on to glory to be with the Lord. Sister Alice was 101 years old and will join her husband, Burton F. Lisby, where they will walk on with the Lord forever. They were married for more than sixty-nine years. Sister Alice was a devoted member of the Gospel Choir, Might Mass Choir, and Women's Guild at Payne Memorial A.M.E. Church.

In the early years of her life, Sister Alice attended primary and secondary schools in Havre de Grace and Baltimore, Maryland. She worked numerous jobs that are too many to list in this brief space; but she was especially proud of the work she did at the Aberdeen Proving Grounds, Maryland Workshop for the Blind, (now called the Blind Industries of Maryland), and the nineteen (19) years of dedicated service with Marriott In-Flight Services at BWI Airport, from which she retired in 1982.

As many of you know, Sister Alice was known throughout the family and community for her excellent cooking skills, humor, and original statements about life, relationships and raising children. Her advice on any one of these subjects could be blunt at times, but never given in malicious or hurtful intentions. As she would always say, "I know what I'm talking about!"

As we say our final farewells to Sister Alice, please continue to pray for God's blessings on her surviving sister: Mrs. Mary Milburn; five (5) children, Constance I. Williams, Donald B.
