Alice Pearl Hicks-Timmons, was born in Cartersville, South Carolina on December 31, 1917 to the late Charlie and Annie Sue James-Hicks. She was one of four children, the late Charlie, Jr. "Stick", Katheline Williams, "Boog", and the late Rev. John Wesley Hicks, "Boot". At an early age, Alice accepted the Lord Jesus Christ as her personal Savior and joined New Haven United Methodist Church, in Catersville. She relocated with her husband Aurin (the late A.C. Timmons) and children to Baltimore, Maryland in 1944. In 1946, she and her husband joined John Wesley Methodist Church on Sharp Street. They continued their membership when the church moved to its present location and until deaths.

As a faithful servant of the Lord, Ms. Timmons was an usher and a nurse. Education was important to her and as such, she graduated from Frederick Douglas Night School with a certificate in Home Health Care. She worked as a private duty nurse until retirement.

Alice loved her family and spent many hours nourishing, loving, and providing moral support to them. She spoke with pride about her three sons graduating from college. She loved to follow the progress of her grands, great and great, great grandchildren.

Alice was a generous, caring, and compassionate person to everyone,

especially to those less fortunate or down on their luck. She knew that everyone was not as fortunate as she and would give moral and financial support to assist and aide them.

She was a champion for equal rights and expressed it through vocal and financial contributions and voting. She enjoyed engaging into political conversation. At 100 years plus 7 months, Alice passed away in Deerfield Beach, Florida on August 17, 2018 surrounded by her two sons.

She was preceded in death by her husband of seventy years, A.C., her son, Lt. Col. (ret) Aurin, Jr., daughter, Jean, and two brothers, Charles and Rev John Hicks. For the last ten years she was a snowbird from December to May and resided in Deerfield Beach, Florida with her two sons.
