Aljawanna "Nicole" Owens was born October 5, 1979 to Lynda G. Owens and Charles E. Taylor. Nicole was a life-long resident of Richmond, Virginia. She was baptized at Greater Mt. Moriah Baptist Church, while her mother was an associate minister. She was a 1997 graduate of John F. Kennedy High School, where she was actively involved in the marching band and Junior ROTC. She continued her education at J. Sargeant Reynolds Community and Bryant and Stratton Colleges.

Nicole was the "baby" of the family and enjoyed spending time with her mother, siblings, nieces and nephews. She was an attentive and devoted daughter, who took numerous leaves of absence to care for her mother while she was convalescing from illness. Nicole shared a special and unique relationship with each of her siblings. She often sought guidance and leadership from her Big Brother Larry, shared long sisterly conversations with Big Sister LaTisha, and shared a home with Brother Solomon. She was known affectionately as "Aunt Bubbles" by her nieces and nephews.

Nicole was a very down to earth person with an expressive personality accentuated with a happy, fun-loving disposition. She enjoyed life to the fullest. After graduating from high school, Nicole began a career with the Commonwealth of Virginia Department of Corrections. During her tenure with the state, she worked at Beaumont and Hanover Juvenile Correctional Centers

and Henrico County and Riverside Regional Jails. As a testament to her magnetic personality, her coworkers and even the inmates called her "Sunshine."

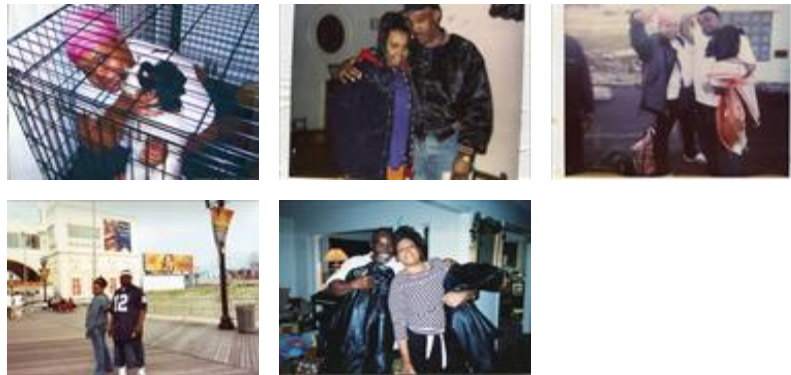

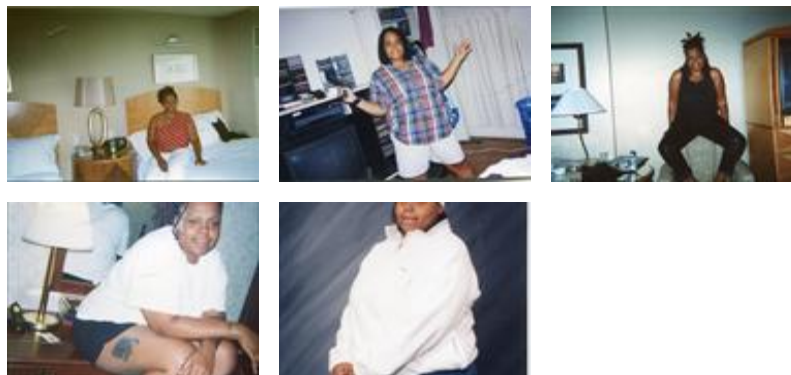

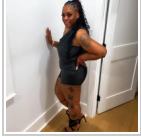
