



## Alma R. Simmons

April 24, 1919 - September 21, 2002

Alma Roberta Simmons received her joy and victory at 5:30a.m. on September 21, 2002 at Manor Care nursing Home in Towson, Maryland after a lengthy illness. Alma was born to Richard and Martha Allen Butts on April 24, 1919 in Greensville County, Virginia. She received her early education there and while still quite young, she accepted Christ as her Lord and Savior and joined Macedonian Baptist Church where she remained a faithful member, even after moving her residence to Baltimore, Maryland. In Baltimore she continued her spiritual walk with the Lord at David Memorial Baptist Church and finally at First mount Olive Freewill Baptist Church. Alma was united in marriage to Albert Francis Simmons on April 26, 1935 who preceded her in death. To this union, three children were born, Dorothy Mae, who also preceded her in death, Alfred Nathaniel and Alma Ruth. While raising her family, Alma worked outside the home in several industries; oyster packing, laundry and dry cleaning. She was a gifted seamstress and on occasion sewed all the gowns for bridesmaids for weddings. Her hobbies included word search puzzles, fishing, cooking and baking for her family. She is also survived by six grandchildren, fifteen great grandchildren, three treat-great grandchildren; a sister, Mamie Butts Wilks; a brother, George Roosevelt Butts; two sons-in-law, one daughter-in-law, five sisters-in-law, three brothers-in-law, and a host of other relatives and friends.
