On a peaceful, brief Fall morning, as nature continued its transformation from the old to the new, so did our beloved, Alma Inez Robinson. She departed this life October 20, 2012. At the age of 91, she leaves a legacy built upon unyielding faith, dedication for the stick and love for her family. As written in the scripture of her favorite book Isaiah, 43 “ when thou passed through the waters, I will be with thee; when thou walking through the fire, thou shall not be burned; neither shall the flame kindle upon thee..
