



## Alonzo McLeod Jr.

Alonzo McLeod, Jr. was born on January 24, 1944 to the late Ardelia and Alonzo, Sr. He departed this life on July 5, 2015.

Alonzo was affectionately known as Junior to many and as Pop-Pop to his children and grandchildren. He was educated in the Baltimore City Public School System. Upon completion of his education, he became an engineer with the Baltimore City Housing Authority. He completed his engineering degree, and went to work at the then Amstar Corporation (Domino Sugar). He retired from Domino to begin his own business - McLeod's Heating and Cooling. In addition to his work with McLeod's Heating and Cooling, he traveled and spent time with his family and their special dog, Craig Lee. He gave his life to Christ at an early age. He was a member of the New Shiloh Baptist Church and most recently attended the Union Bethel AME Church of Randallstown, Maryland.
