



Alvin Storrs Henderson

December 28, 1928 - November 7, 2014

Alvin Storrs Henderson Sr., son of the late Virginia Storrs Henderson and the late James Randolph Henderson, was born in Richmond, Virginia, on December 28, 1928. He was the youngest of 13 children. He died at the Brighton Gardens Reminiscence Center in Columbia, Maryland, on Friday, November 7, 2014, due to complications of Alzheimer's disease.

Alvin enlisted in the United States Air Force and served his country before being honorably discharged in July 1952. He then received his B.S. from Virginia Union University, and completed graduate-level studies at the University of Maryland. He was employed for more than 30 years as an Operations Research Analyst at Aberdeen Proving Ground, until he retired in 1988.

Alvin was an active member of Grace Presbyterian Church for most of his adult life, and served as an Elder and Sunday School Teacher. He was passionate about the value of education, which led him to organize and conduct an after-school program for vulnerable middle-school students.

Alvin is survived by his wife of 62 years, Florence Gundy Henderson of Baltimore, Maryland; his older daughter Phyllis Carlene Sinex of Columbia, Maryland; his son Alvin Storrs Henderson, Jr. of Baltimore, Maryland; and his younger daughter Deborah Janene Henderson of Kirkland, Washington.

He is also mourned by his sister Ruth Henderson Gaskins of The Bronx, New York; ; his older grandson Phillip Henderson Sinex of Erie, Pennsylvania; and a host of nieces, nephews, cousins, and friends.

In death, he will be reunited with his younger grandson Owen Robert Sinex and older brother, Dallas Glenwood Henderson, Sr.
