According to his family and friends, he was a social outspoken conservative while loving his memberships in many different organizations. Alvin collected articles, tapes, newspapers, pictures and magazines that he liked sharing with others. Many Afrikans will remember his many visits to their homeland, especially Ghana. His family, loved ones, particularly his daughter Valerie and his sons, Alvin Jr. and William supported him 100% throughout his illness.
