ALVIN T. ROBINSON, son of the late Paul T. and Louise H. Robinson, was born on November 26, 1922 in Baltimore, Maryland. He departed this life on January 21, 2009 after a series of illnesses. He graduated from Douglass High School in Baltimore in 1940, joined the U.S. Army in 1943 and became a distinguished member of the 1311th Engineering Regiment until 1946. He is registered in the Hall of Remembrance in the World War II Memorial on the national Mall in Washington, D.C. Alvin began working for Bethlehem Steel ultimately becoming supervisor. He earned a degree in Unionization from Penn State University and was elected Trustee for the United Steel Workers of America, Local #2610, in 1958. He held numerous union positions and was a shop steward upon retirement in 1982. In 1955, he married Martha Sullivan and remained married for forty-nine years, until her death in 2004. This union produced two loving sons, Alvin and Michael. Alvin became a property owner and landlord of several properties. He was an active member of his homeowners' cooperative and was elected president in 1997. Although not an active member of a church, he was very spiritual and was a devoted husband and father. He is survived by: two sons, Alvin, Jr. and Michael; two grandchildren, Megan and Mia; two brothers, Herman and Carroll; sister, Mildred Cole; a host of other relatives and friends.
