On December 6, 2013, ANDREW HENSON, affectionately known as “Sonny”, fell asleep in death in Finksburg, Maryland at the age of 83.

Andrew was born on November 23, 1930 in Baltimore, Maryland to Albert Henson and Edna (Lance) Henson. Andrew attended Carver Vocational-Technical High School and he proudly called himself a “Carverite”, even up until his death. He enlisted in the U.S. Army in 1948 and was honorably discharged in 1952, in which year he married the love of his life, Vera Evans. Andrew and Vera remained married until Vera's untimely death in 1991. From this union were born, the late Andrew Bernard Jr., Keith Lamont, Renee Yvette, and Nikki Desiree. His family continued to grow as his beloved grandchildren became an important part of his life: Andrew III, Danielle, Erica, Kelli, Vincent (Lamont), Christopher, Adriane and Dea. Andrew later married Joanne Tarver.

Andrew worked very hard to support and care for his family by working over 40 years at Bethlehem Steel Corporation, from which he retired in 1993. However, his proudest moment was when he was baptized as one of Jehovah's Witnesses on July 19, 1968. Andrew served as an elder and pioneer in the Rosemont Congregation for many years. He shared with everyone he met his confidence in God's Kingdom and the wonderful things it will soon accomplish.
