Andrew Mobley, son of the late Law and Nannie Foster Mobley, was born on August 10, 1934 in Winnsboro, South Carolina. He departed this life on October 26, 2001 after a lengthy illness. Andrew and his family moved to Baltimore in 1941. He attended Douglass High School where he excelled in track and field, football and basketball. He enlisted in the United States Army in 1951 where he served in Korea during the Korean Conflict. He was honorably discharged in 1954 and received the Purple Heart. He enlisted in the United States Air Force in 1955, where he served as an Airborne Radio Operator. His first assignment was with Air and Sea Rescue in Thule, Greenland. He completed his career flying aboard the Strategic Air command Looking Glass Airborne Command Post. He retired from the air force with distinction in 1954. After retirement, he attended Bellevue College in Bellevue, Nebraska. He also worked as a car salesman and for the U.S. Postal Service. Andrew married the former Delores Terry in 1957.
