



## Andrew Nance Sr.

On May 19, 1932 marks the day the late Plumie Nance and Joseph Nance were blessed with a son, the fifth of six children, Andrew Nance. Born in Rockhill, SC of a sharecropper's family, Andrew learned the value of being a hardworking man. Andrew was well known as a hard worker until he departed this life on May 1, 2018. After a few years of battling illness, God called him home for a job well done.

Andrew will unite with his siblings who preceded him in death, Ronell (aka Buck), Thomas (aka June), Mozelle, Maggie, Bertha (aka Bert).

As a teenager, Andrew relocated to Baltimore, MD where he developed his many skills and talents. Andrew gained employment at Bethlehem Steel as a steel worker. He dedicated thirty years of service to the State Highway Administration as a supervisor. In October 1996 he was able to retire and receive high accolades for his outstanding service. Andrew began A. Nance Construction where he earned a reputation that exceeded many others in the industry. As an owner-operator contractor he specialized in construction and concrete until 82 years of age. Of his many outstanding jobs a few are highly recognized such as the Alpha Kappa Alpha Building. Florence Betel Gym and the express Care Building. Andrew found it difficult to rest in retirement and continued to engage as a consultant and advisor to many colleagues, family and friends in the construction industry until his death.

Andrew gave his life to Christ at any early age. He fellowshiped at the New Union Baptist Church under the leadership of Rev. Charles E. Salvage. He loved to hear the word of God. After his illness hindered him from participating in Sunday worship services he kept his church family in his heart and prayers.

Andrew was educated in the Baltimore City Public School System. After years of hard work and determination he received his high school diploma in 1991. Andrew was the life of the party, hosting gatherings for family and friends. He brought smiles and laughter to everyone in his company. He enjoyed card games under "house rules", checkers, and going to the casino. He was a sharp dresser, who took pride in his appearance. As a young dapper gentleman, he also took pride in his leadership role as President of the Royal Viking Motorcycle Club. As a retired gentleman, Andrew enjoyed watching Family Feud, Judge Judy, and baseball games.

Andrew had many good days and when sickness fell upon him he had some bad days. There is one thing that must be said about Andrew, he never complained. Not one grumble or gripe. He pushed forward each day with a nod and a wave but never a complaint. We all were blessed by such a man of courage, strength and integrity. We all learned so much from him to carry on throughout the days to come.

In 1953 Andrew met the love of his life, his wife, Dorothy Nance who preceded him in death. They shared an unbreakable bond until her death in October, 2005. Andrew was the proud father of eleven children of which were six sons and five daughters. His children could always count on their Pop and they all loved their Dad. One sister-in-law, Dorothy Mae Weston; and three children preceded him in death, Andrew Jr., Ronald and Corliss.

Andrew leaves eight children, three daughters-in-law, and three son-in-law to

celebrate his life, Thomas (Gloria), Denise, Gino, Tyrone Sr. (Wanda). Angela Lewis (Mark), Shrone McClinton (Johnny), Andre Sr. (Nita), and Marie Holden (Jay). Andrew leaves twenty-eight grandchildren, a total of four generations to carry on his legacy, along with a host of nieces, nephews, family and friends.

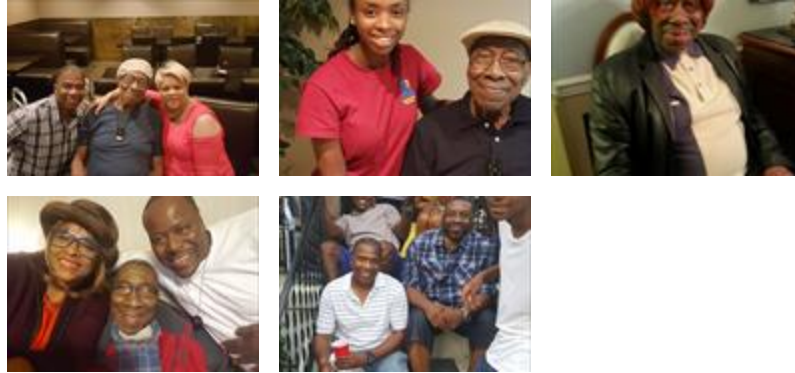
