When my dad died, I found out that I was not the baby, but was the middle child of 7. It was just more family to love.

I have always loved Jesus ever since I found out in Sunday school that He died for me so I could live. Finally, I found God. I learned to fear (respect and reverence) God. Life got better. Then, I learned to tithe and life got a whole lot better. Jesus said He was going to prepare a place for me in His Father's house. I'll be waiting to see each of you there when the trumpet sounds.

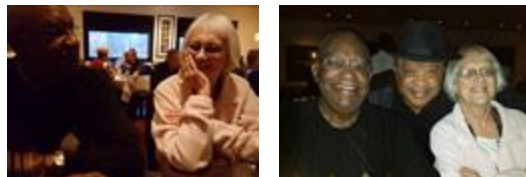
