Ann accepted the Lord at a young age. She was a member of the United Baptist Church under the pastorate of the late Rev. George E. Vanderford. Ann received her education in the Baltimore City public school system and graduated from Carver Vocational Technical High School. She was employed by the Social Security Administration until she retired.

Ann married the late Isaiah Paul Spriggs. From this union came four children, Colleen, Teresa, Deanna and Isaiah Spriggs Jr. Providing for her children was her greatest accomplishment and what she took the most pride in.

Ann enjoyed reading, shopping and nurturing young people. Her home was always a safe haven for children, where they could come for a nutritious meal, tutoring for school and play games. They also enjoyed singing and dancing to her educational albums. In her community she was also known as an avid civil rights activist who empowered many.

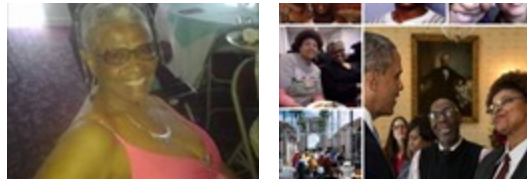
