Her early work began in the The Bronx, New York, and she worked in various hospitals and laboratories throughout Maryland. Annette had been employed by Greater Baltimore Medical Center since 1971, retiring in March of 2013, but simultaneously worked full time for Baltimore County General Hospital (nineteen years) during that forty-three year time frame. She's worked in laboratories operated by the U.S. Army (Kaiserslautern, Germany), U.S. Federal, and British governments.
