ANNIE GERTRUDE PHILLIPS was born to the late Henry Phillips and Mattie Phillips on April 8, 1920. She is the last of fifteen children to move to an estate behind the Pearly Gates. Annie departed this life on Monday December 6, 2010.

Annie was born and raised in Gloucester, Virginia until the age of sixteen, when she moved to Baltimore, Maryland. She completed her education at Paul Laurence Dunbar High School. She had five children, three of whom preceded her in death.

She was a member of Cornerstone Baptist Church of Christ where she sang on the choir and served on the usher board. She was a domestic worker for several years. Later she worked in the kitchen at Union Memorial Hospital and at the University of Maryland Hospital as a laundry technician until she retired.

Annie was the matriarch of the Phillips family. She was the glue that kept the family together. She had a quite and giving spirit and was always willing to help others if she could. The doors of her home were always open when family and friends were in need of a place to stay. If there was anything you needed, she would say "wait a minute let me check". She would find it within ten minutes or would have it for you in a few days.

In the late 70's she joined a social club of women over fifty called the "Latecomers". She loved reading her Bible, shopping at thrift stores all around Baltimore, playing cards especially pinochle and doing search -a-word puzzles. She attended the Oliver center adult Day Care where she loved playing bingo and dancing.

She leaves to cherish her memory: two daughters, Annie Harper and Gwendolyn Frazier; sister-in-law, Beatrice Phillips; nine grandchildren, twenty-one great-grandchildren and two great-great-grandchildren; and a host of other relatives and friends. She will be truly missed by all she knew and loved her.
