Anton was not afraid to challenge himself or anything if it came to mind. he made it happen. He dedicated himself to his goals and beliefs, often trying to teach others everything he knew. He took the time to mentor those around him and push them to their limits. Many can agree that he was a natural born leader. Anton was always down for a good debate. In fact, the exchange didn't end unless the other party walked away or persuaded on his perspective of things.

Anton was a selfless individual who took pride in the love he had for his family. There was no limit to the extent he would go to for his loved ones, especially his sisters.
