Antonio Patrick Harrison, youngest son of Antoinette and James T. Harrison Jr. III, was born on June 25, 1979 in Baltimore, Maryland. He departed this life suddenly on December 22, 2004 after a fatal car accident. "Boofield", "The Boo", or "Field" as he was affectionately known, received his education in the Baltimore City Public School System and achieved his GED through the Civil Works Program. Field held a variety of jobs, but he preferred construction work; and he was last employed by the Baltimore City Department of Housing as a boarding crew member. In the summer of 2001, while attending the New Light Church, Field accepted Jesus Christ as his Savior and experienced a peace as never before. Field's top priority day to day was his family and friends. He loved his children, and likewise they adored their father. Field also loved being with his "boys" and the people of the 300 block of 28th Street. Field will be fondly remembered for his love of singing and dancing which was evidenced by his boom box and his enjoyment of community block parties. Field's favorite song was Sam Cooke's "A Change is Gonna Come". Field also enjoyed cruising in big luxury vehicles such as his first car, a 1978 Chevy Caprice, and his last car, a '96 white on white Cadillac Deville.
