Armest Lee Bell was born on November 11, 1939 to the late Fountain and Sophie Bell in Ayden/Pitt County, North Carolina. He received his education in the South Ayden Public School System.

After a lengthy illness, Armest entered eternal rest with the Lord on December 29, 2016 at the Gilchrist Hospice Center.

Affectionately known as "Uncle Luddie," he was an entrepreneur in his own right and the best seller of sticky apples, frozen cups, and snowballs in all of East Baltimore. Luddie's favorite pastime was reading and studying the Word of God and witnessing to others. Although he was never a licensed Evangelist, he evangelized wherever he went. Luddie's favorite saying to every situation and circumstance was "If it wasn't for the Lord on my side, where would I be."

Armest accepted the Lord, Jesus Christ at an early age and was a member of the Pleasant Plain United Holiness Church in Grifton, NC. After moving to Baltimore, he joined the Highway Christian Church under the leadership of the Pastor Wesley Thomas. He was a faithful member of the Sunday School, the Male Chorus (Brotherhood), and the Adult choir. Armest married the former Virgie Fliggins and from this union one son, Byron was born.

Luddie had three brothers, Earl, Willie (Melt), Thurman Sr., and one sister, Marjorie (Teena) to precede him in death.
