August 10, 1912 - January 9, 2011

ARRIE VERN BLANCHE FREEMAN, daughter of the late Landon and Ella Tate Cox, was born on Saturday, August 10, 1912 in Richmond County, Virginia.

She attended boarding school in Virginia before moving to Baltimore, Maryland where she attended Frederick Douglass Senior High School and met Williams E. Hayes, Sr. whom she married and built her family. Their six children are: Williams E. Hayes, Jr., Aritha M. Hayes, Ruth E. McNeill, and the late Rita, Naomi and George Hayes. William Sr. lost his battle with liver cancer in 1977. Later, Arrie married Frank Freeman and lived in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania until he was called home to be with the Lord. While residing in Philadelphia, she worked briefly in the Dietary Department at one of the City's convalescent homes. She became a mentor to unwed mothers and opened her home to several of these young women and assisted them until they were able to provide for themselves. She was a faithful member of her neighborhood's Baptist Church. After Frank's death, she returned to Baltimore to live. Soon after she found Trinity Baptist Church, where she attended Sunday School and became a devoted member of the Missions Ministry. In 1993 she was diagnosed with Alzheimer's Disease, which limited Church, family and social activities.

On Sunday morning, January 9, 2011, Arrie was called home to be with Lord

after ninety-eight years of life. Arrie is survived by: sister, Edna Swift; son, William Jr.; daughters, Aritha and Ruth; six grandsons, two granddaughters, six great-grandsons, eight great-granddaughters, one great-great-grandson; nine nieces and nephews and their respective children; who will miss her dearly but find comfort in knowing she has earned her Angel wings and will watch over them forever more.
