



## Arthell Harris

February 14, 1951 - December 25, 2011

Arthell Harris, beloved son of Lucinda Harris and the late John Walker Morris was born February 14, 1951 in Drew, Mississippi. He went to rest in the Lord on one of the most sacred days of the year. Sunday, December 25, 2011 Jesus' Birthday (Christmas Day). He was in the place where he wanted to be with those he wanted to be with, his wife and sons.

“Paul” as he was affectionately known by all, attended Drew Elementary and Hunter High School in Mississippi. At an early age, he was baptized at the East Mount Olive Baptist Church under the leadership of Pastor R.C. Gallain.
