ARTHUR W. ADAMS, JR., eldest son of the late Arthur and Dorothy Adams, was born September 16, 1938 in Baltimore, Maryland. He departed this life on January 9, 2014 after a long illness.

Arthur was educated in the Baltimore City Public School System. As a child, he received his Christian foundation at Southern Baptist Church. Early in life, Arthur decided to pursue a career in the supermarket business. He started at a small grocery store called Ben's. He went on to manage a well-known supermarket in East Baltimore (The American Food Store) serving in various positions from butcher to manager. He was also the first African American manager of that store.

He was an avid fisherman and enjoyed fishing at his favorite watering holes. He was well known and respected in the community and provided a watchful eye, often perched from his bedroom window or sitting on the steps. He always showed love for those who were less fortunate, often giving his last to help someone in need.

He married Barbara Johnson; and from this union, two children were born.

He leaves to cherish in his memory two daughter Valerie and Vanessa; two

sons, Arthur III and Kevin; one sister , Gwendolyn Cunningham; one son-in-law and one brother-in-law. He also leaves two brothers, Calvin and Jerry; and one sister, Marlene—all whom preceded him in death; six grandchildren, three great grand children, four devoted friends, Monroe, Betty, Melvina, and Claire and a host of nieces, nephews, cousins, godchildren and friends.
