Arthur Edward Morris, 82, of Richmond, Virginia, departed this life on Wednesday, December 10, 2008. He was the youngest of five children born to the late Jesse and Sophia Houston Morris. He was born on October 11, 1926, in Louisa County, Virginia. His parents died during his infancy and he was reared by his sister and her husband, the late Roseanna and Emmett Wormley. Other siblings preceding him in death include Fred and Percy Morris and Lucille Smith. He was reared and educated in Louisa County. He enlisted in the army and served during the Korean Conflict. He was a marksman and trained new recruits. Arthur was honorably discharged and continued his service in the army reserves. On November 29, 1954, he married his childhood sweetheart, Lillian Talley, who preceded him in death on October 17, 1987. To this union two children were born, Arthur Morris, Jr., who died approximately 12 hours after his birth and Shirley Morris Hart. They made their home in Richmond, Virginia. He was employed by F.W. Woolworth, retiring after 34 years of service in 1989 as the stock room manager. Arthur (along with his wife) obeyed the gospel in the late 1950's and continued as a faithful member of the Church of God until his death. He loved the Lord and served as song leader, treasurer and most recently as an usher. He was easygoing and will long be remembered for his ready smile, warm handshake, quick wit, neat "afro" and impeccable dress. He leaves to treasure precious memories, his beloved and devoted daughter, Shirley Morris Hart; one beloved as a son, Rodney Simms; one goddaughter, Candice Blount; one
