Arthur Lee Wall Jr., eldest son of the late Arthur L. Wall Sr. and Mary E. Buckner Wall was born September 1, 1941 in Baltimore, Maryland. He was educated in Baltimore City Public Schools and graduated from Frederick Douglass High School in 1959. He received his Bachelors degree from Morgan State College and a Masters degree from Coppin State College in 1974. Arthur Wall was life member of Alpha Phi Omega Service Fraternity and the co-founder of the Alumni Chapter where he held many leadership positions. He was also the co-founder with his wife of Christ Is King the ministry of the Holy Trinity, Inc. He was saved and transformed by the power of God. Art was honorably discharged from the United States Army in 1966 and was a member of the Army Reserves from 1966-1968. He was employed as an administrator at Baltimore City Department of Social Services (later renamed Maryland State Dept. Human Resources) for over 30 years from which he retired in 1996. He was Chief of Staff for the President of the Baltimore City Council from 1998-2000. After retirement, he was a substitute teacher and a volunteer tutor with Baltimore City Public Schools. He later worked as a Cafeteria aide at Randallstown Elementary, his granddaughter's school. He was volunteer administrator with the Military Youth corp. for several years. Art was an avid gardener with the Columbia Gardeners Association and a very generous donor to many human service organizations. Arthur is survived by his loving and devoted wife, Loretta Yvonne Lewis Wall of over 35 years; his dedicated children Debra Yvonne Wall Barbour and Darin

Christopher Wall; three granddaughters who were “ his girls” Jordan Elisabeth Barbour, Jaryn Rebekah Barbour, and Joelle Yvonne Taliaferro; his devoted brother Charles Allen Wall and Sisters Jacqueline Palmer and Patricia Stanley. He is also survived by maternal aunts Beulah Buckner Fogle, Charlene Buckner Griffin, and uncle Dennard C. Griffin and cousins Andrea Gholston, Calvin Gholston, Carol Opher, James Wall Jr. and Doris Buckner White. He gave loving support and guidance to his many nieces and nephews especially Clinton B.
