



## Arthur Meredith Logan

August 9, 1940 - April 2, 2014

On Wednesday, April 2, 2014, Jesus said, "Come Unto Me and Rest." Arthur Meredith Logan, a loving husband, father, grandfather and great-grandfather took his journey.

Arthur was born to the late Elizabeth and Floyd Logan, Sr., on August 9, 1940. He attended Virginia Randolph School. He was employed by Lone Star for many years before employment at Philip Morris, where he retired after 15 years of service.

Arthur set out one Sunday morning in 2004, to go Second Elam Baptist Church where his long-time neighbor and friend, Reverend Russell Crawley pastored, to give his life to Christ. But when he arrived no one was there because no service was being held that day. But that didn't deter Arthur, he was determined to give his life to Christ that day, so he stopped at Rising Mount Zion Baptist in New Kent, where he confessed Christ. Pastor Crawley later told him that he had made a great choice. On October 10, 2004, at the age of 64, Arthur was baptized at Rising Mount Zion and attended church regularly until his health began to fail.
