Who can forget her scrumptious cod fish, cakes, sweet potato pies, and rice pudding! The neighbors waited for her weekend dinners to be sold. She enjoyed occasional trips to Atlantic City with friends.

Atlean had a servant's heart and we celebrate her as a blessing from God. On Friday, May 18, 2018 Atlean entered the presence of the Lord: Her two

Daughters Cynthia and Charlene and "Buddy Mose" (the love of her life) preceded her in death.
