Audrey was the only one in her class to accomplish this. She held several jobs. The longest tenure was with the London Town Manufacturing Company where she worked as a seamstress for thirty-three years before the plant closed. After completing training at the Eastside Career Center, Audrey worked at Interface. When that plant closed, she worked at Rockland until her retirement in September 2003. Audrey married John Poindexter on August 17, 1957. Out of this union, five children were born—Terri, John Jr., Kevin, Kim and Audrey. On April 28, 1973, Audrey married MacArthur Wright. The late Pastor Matthew Wilkerson baptized her, at age seven. Except for a two-year period when Audrey was a member of the Prince of Peace Baptist Church, she has been a disciple of the Zion Baptist Church. Audrey used her musical talents to the glory of God. She was an active participant in the music ministry for more than thirty years. Also, Audrey and Thelma sang duets in Zion and many churches around the City. During a recent stay at the rehabilitation center, Audrey continued her ministry as she sang and played hymns for the patients. Audrey leaves to cherish her memory: five children, Terri Byrd, John Poindexter Jr., Kevin Poindexter, Kim Fedd and Audrey Poindexter; a sister,
