On May 20, 1928, AUGUSTUS GILBERT LEONARD, JR., affectionately known as Piggie, son of the late Augustus and Mabel Leonard, was born in Baltimore, Maryland. He departed this life on April 7, 2013 after a lengthy illness.

He received his education in the Baltimore City Public School System. After graduating from Frederick Douglas High School, he enlisted in the United States Navy during World War II. He proudly served his country until November of 1947.
